Why do we use passive voice?

Active voice: - (Subject=Doer)

Passive voice (Be+v3):- (Subject = Receiver)

5 V Obj

Mohan bought a car.

A car was bought by Mohan.

Be verb:-

→Is/Am/Are

→Was/Were

→Been

→Being

If the doer is not known

> His car was stolen yesterday.

> Bronze was discovered around 3500 BC.

If the doer is obvious....

> The thieves were arrested yesterday.

> English is spoken all over the world.

If the doer is irrelevant....

> Your application has been rejected.

> Your account is verified now.

Avoid Responsibility

This T.V. can't be repaired.

Legal statements

> Trespassers will be punished.

Eatables are not allowed inside metro.
