2. Interrogative sentence:-

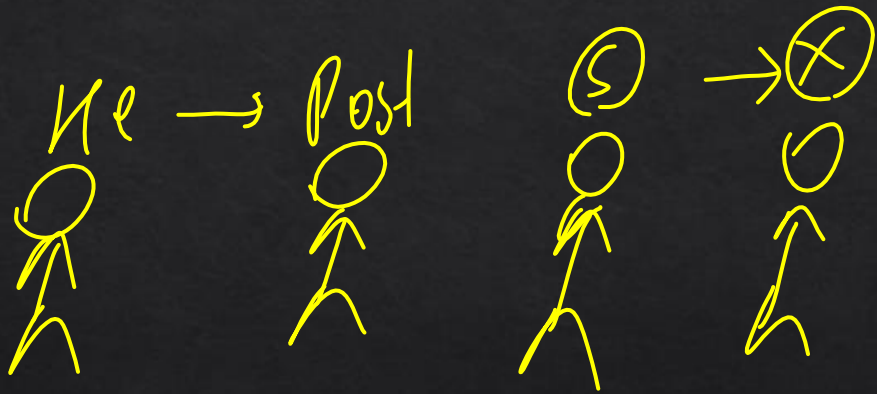
