

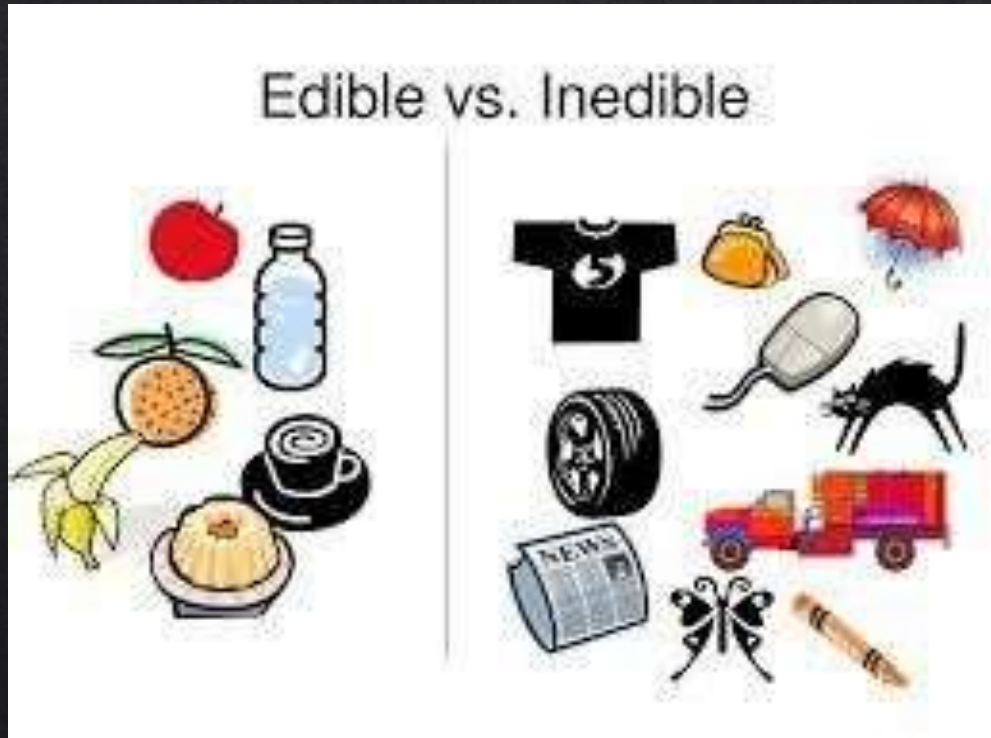
**AMAN SIR ENGLISH**

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**1.Edible** :- Fit to be eaten. खाने योग्य वस्तु

**Mnemonic** :- Eatable



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**Eg:-** My sisters's dinner was barely edible so I ordered takeout instead

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**2.Anarchist :-** A person who believes that law and governments are not necessary. अराजकतावादी

**Root Word :-** an + archy

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**Eg:-** After he was arrested on false charges he became an anarchist.

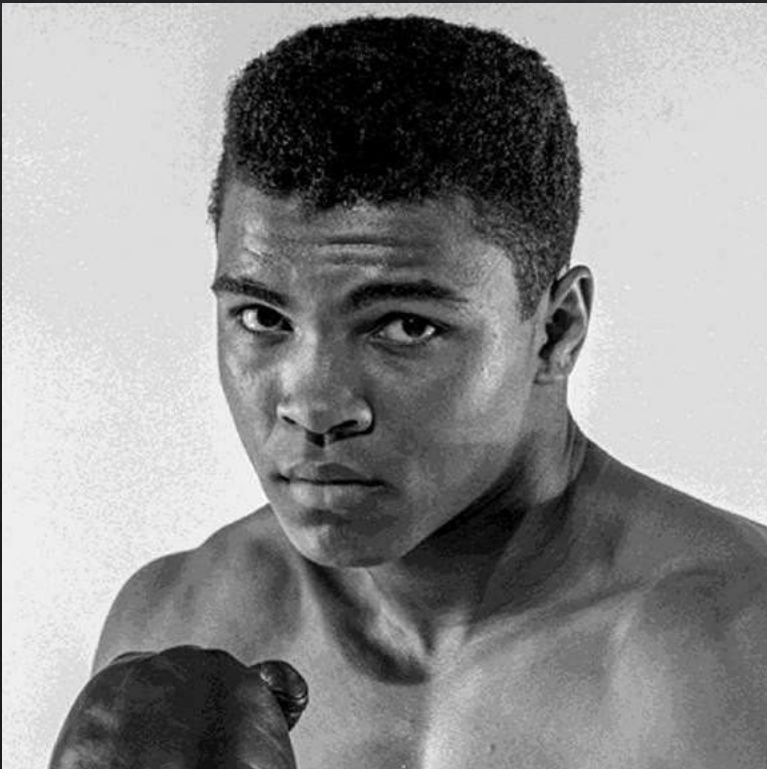
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**3.Apostate:-** a person who renounces a religious or political belief or principle. जो अपने राजनितिक या धार्मिक मत का त्याग कर देता है

**Mnemonics:-** अगर apostate बनोगे तो state छोड़ना पड़ेगा

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**Eg:-** Rajat became an apostate and stopped going to church after his wife was murdered.

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**4.Misanthrope:-** A person who hates and avoids other people. जो मानव जाति से नफरत करता है

**Mnemonics:-** mis + anthrope.

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**Eg:-** The old man was a misanthrope who surrounded his entire yard with barbed wire to keep his neighbors at bay.

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**5.Mint:-** A place where coins, medals, or tokens are made.  
टकसाल

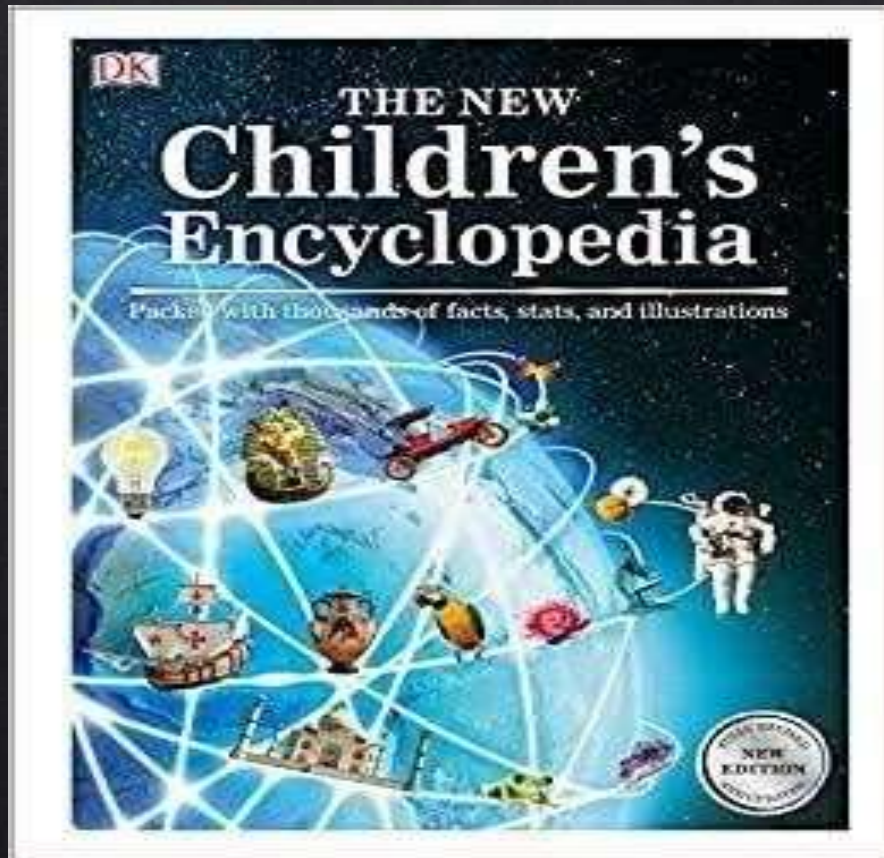


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**Eg:-** No coins for the current year  
have yet come from the mint.

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**6.Encyclopedia** :- A book that contains information on various subjects. विश्वज्ञानकोश



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**Eg:-** The travelling salesman tried to convince the librarian to buy an encyclopedia set with hundreds of different topics inside.

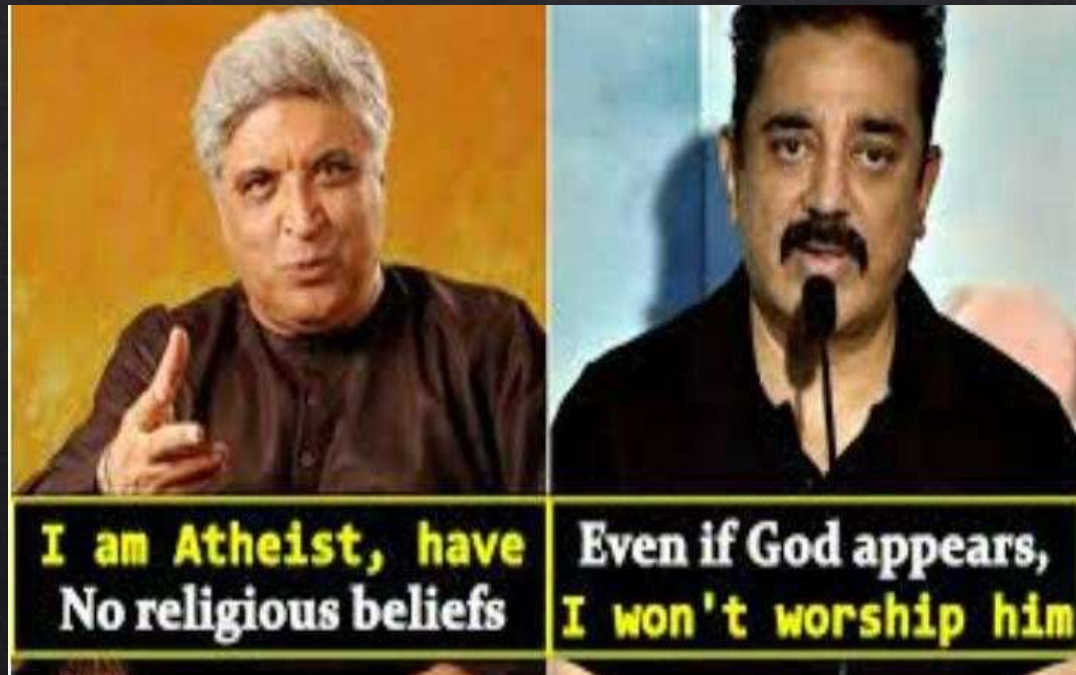
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**7.Atheist:-** One who doesn't believe in God . नास्तिक

**Root word :-** a + theist

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**Eg:-** Because he is an atheist, he has no interest in marrying a church-going woman.

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**8.Bonfire** :- a large fire that is made outside to burn unwanted things, or for pleasure.



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Eg:- After the football game, celebrating fans got together and built a massive outdoor bonfire using old boards to set the blaze.

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**9.Casino:-** A place for gambling. जुआ खेलने की जगह



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**Eg:-** The casino was built so that people in the area would have a nice place to play poker and shoot craps for cash when in town.

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**10.Monotonous:-** Never changing and therefore boring. उबाऊ

**Mnemonics:-** mono + tune

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**Eg:-** Everyone complains about the science teacher's uninteresting and monotonous lectures.

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**11.Mammal:-** any animal in which the female gives birth to babies, not eggs, and feeds them on milk from her own body.  
स्तनधारी



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Eg:- Humans, dogs, elephants, and dolphins are all mammals, but birds, fish, and crocodiles are not.

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**12.Alimony:-** The money paid to the former wife, husband, or partner when the marriage is ended.

**Mnemonic :-** पति से अलग होने पे मिलने वाली money **AMAN SIR ENGLISH**



**Eg:-** He is said to have paid \$300,000 alimony to his first wife.

**13.Caravan:-** a group of travelers, animals, or vehicles traveling together. काफ़िला

**Mnemonic :-** cars का काफिला

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Eg:- When the band tours, there is quite a caravan of vehicles that accompany them.



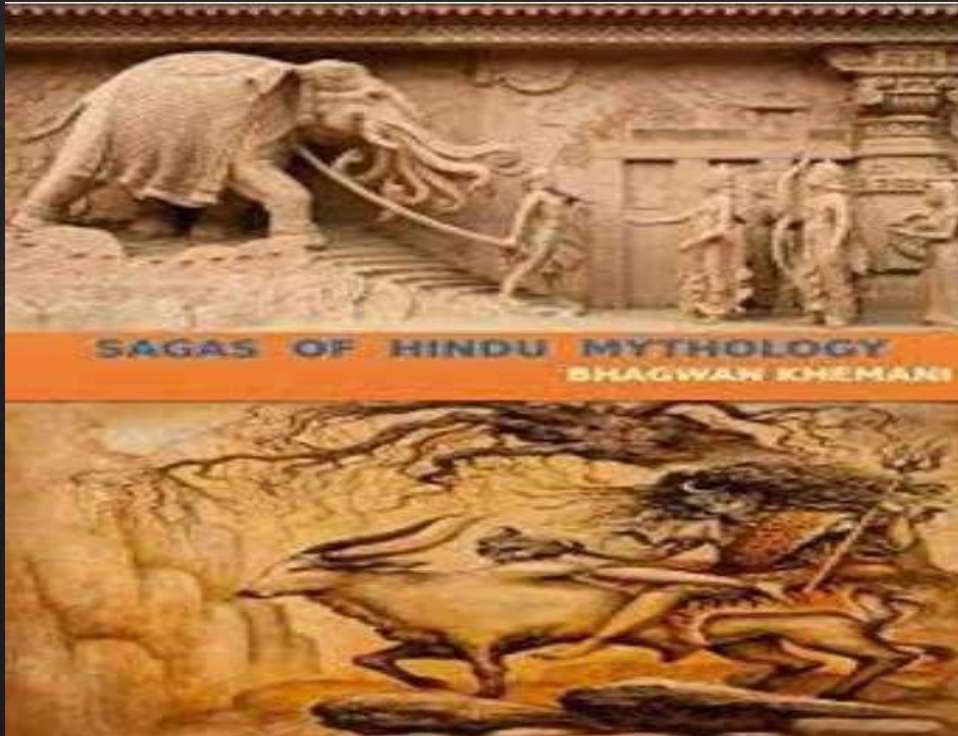
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**14.Saga:-** a long story about past events over a long period of time. प्राचीनकथा

**Mnemonic :-** साधु सुनाते saga

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**Eg:-** The saga about the vampire family was spread into five separate novels.

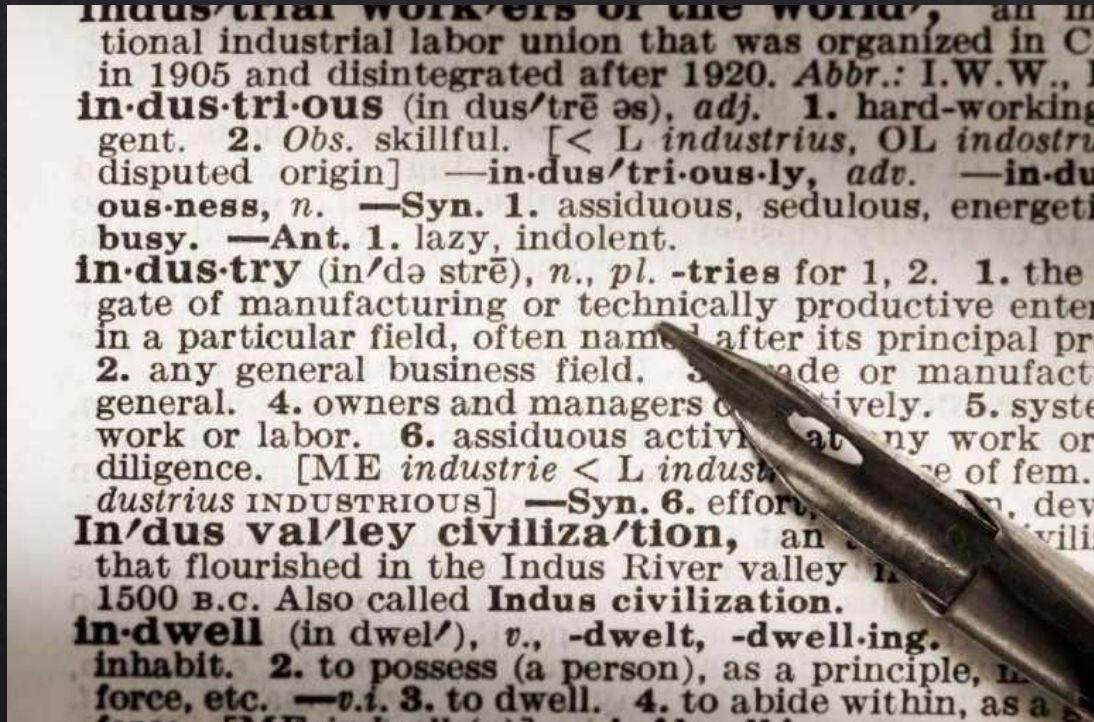
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**15.lexicographer:-** A person who compiles a dictionary.

शब्दकोश लिखने वाला

**Root word -** lexicon(wordbook) + grapher(to write)

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**Eg:-** A lexicographer  
worked as a teacher  
there for some time.

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**16.Shoal:-** A large number of fish swimming together. मछलियों का झुण्ड

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Eg:- Getting lost from the shoal can be dangerous for fish since they are protected in groups.

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**17.Nostalgia** :- a feeling of pleasure and also slight sadness when you think about things that happened in the past: अतीत की याद

**Mnemonic** :- hostel में जो time जिया

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**Eg:-** If my brother sees the family pictures and videos, nostalgia may help him regain his memory.

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**18. Conspiracy:-** A secret plan, made to do something (usually wrong) षड्यंत्र

**Mnemonic :-** cons + piracy

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**Eg:-** The Army suspects the bomb blasts to be the conspiracy of ISI.

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**19.Procrastinate** :- To put off doing something, especially out of habitual carelessness or laziness. टालना

**Mnemonic** :- परसों का बोलकर तीन दिन late

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**Eg:-** The counselor urged the students to not procrastinate in filling out their college applications.

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**20.Samaritan** :- A person who gives help and sympathy to people who need it. मुसीबत में मदद करने वाला

**Mnemonic** :- समाज की भलाई के लिए जतन

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**Eg:-** I'd left my bag in the reception and a good Samaritan came running down the street to give it to me.

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**21.Fastidious:-** one who is hard to please. जिद्दी

**Mnemonic :-** उसकी fastidious girlfriend ने फांसी तो रखी है

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**Eg:-** Arrogant and fastidious, the Diva made no friends on her music tour.

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**22.Cartographer:-** someone who makes or draws map मानचित्रकार



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**Eg:-** With the assistance of a cartographer, the detectives were able to pinpoint the location of the cave on the map.

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**23. Amphibian:-** Animal that lives both on land and water.  
उभयचर

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**Eg:-** Frogs are amphibian animals that can swim in the water and walk on land, and breathe in both scenarios.

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**24.Relic:-** Something belonging to or surviving from an earlier period. अवशेष

**Mnemonic :-** राजा महाराजा के time का

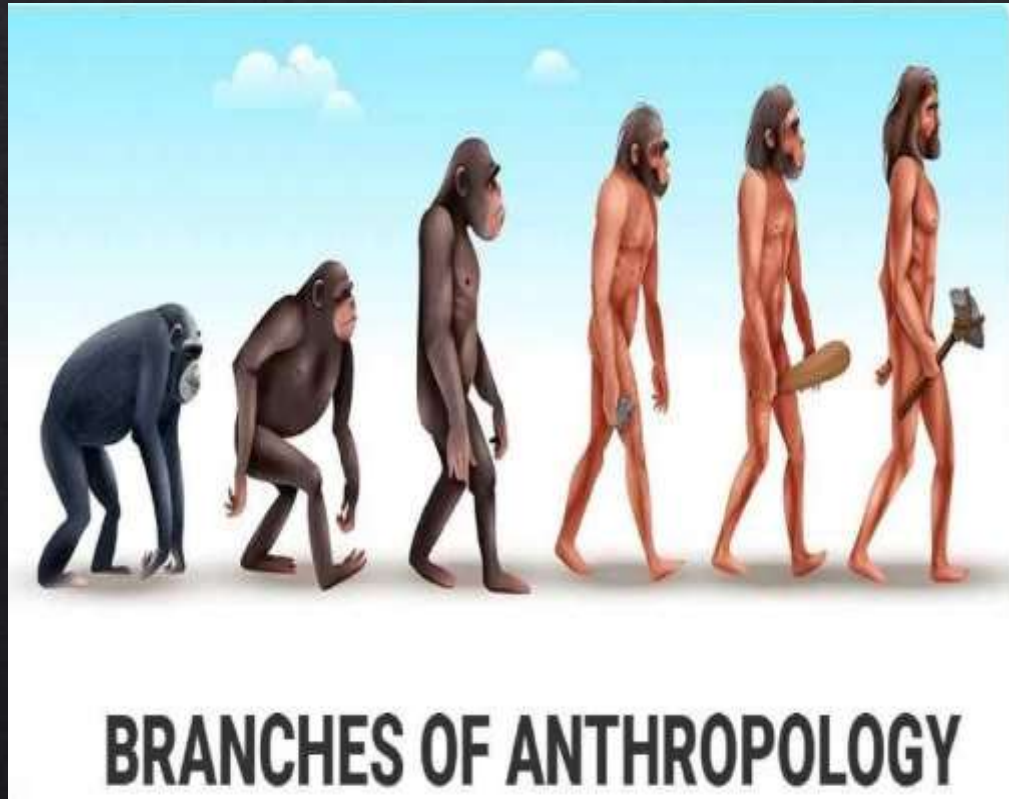
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**Eg:-** They are the last relics of what is now a completely forgotten civilization.

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**25. Anthropology:-** The study of evolution of mankind. मनुष्य जाति का विज्ञान



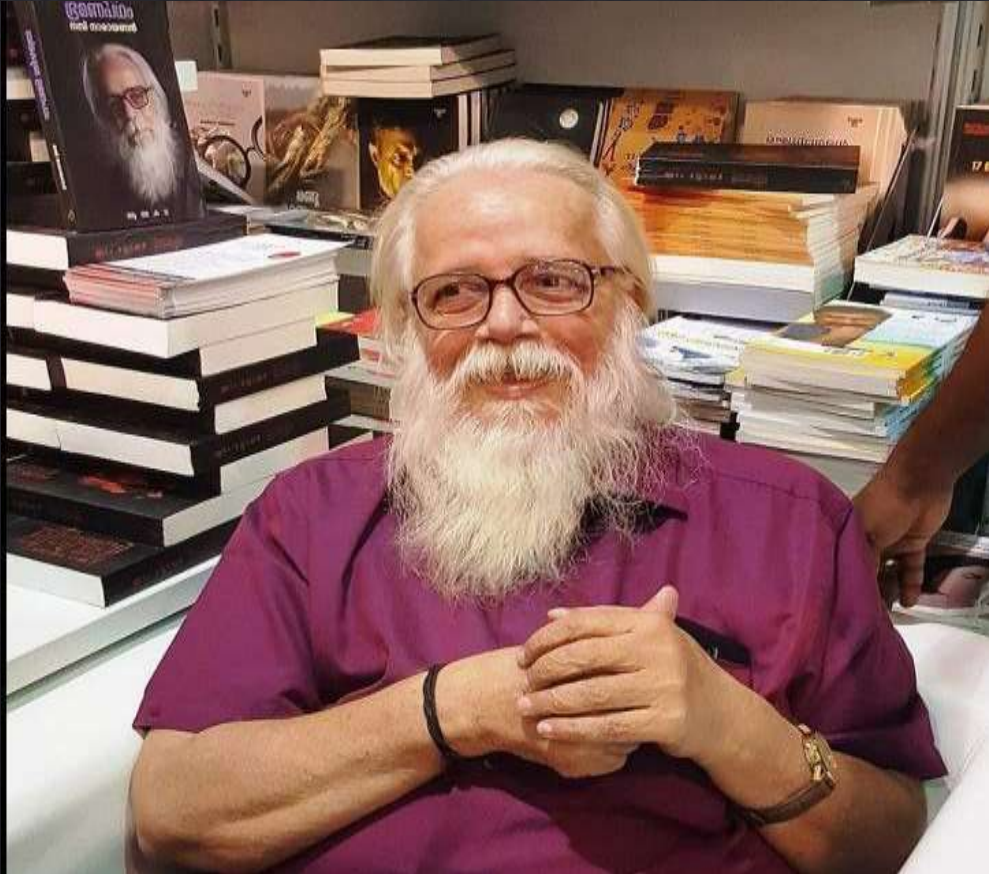
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**Eg:-** In addition to reviewing cultures, the field of anthropology also examines the societal and physical attributes that comprise communities.

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**26.Firm:-** not soft but not completely hard. मजबूत



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**Eg:-** The firm steel-rod could not be broken except under intense pressure.

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**27.Orphan:-** One who has lost one's parents. अनाथ

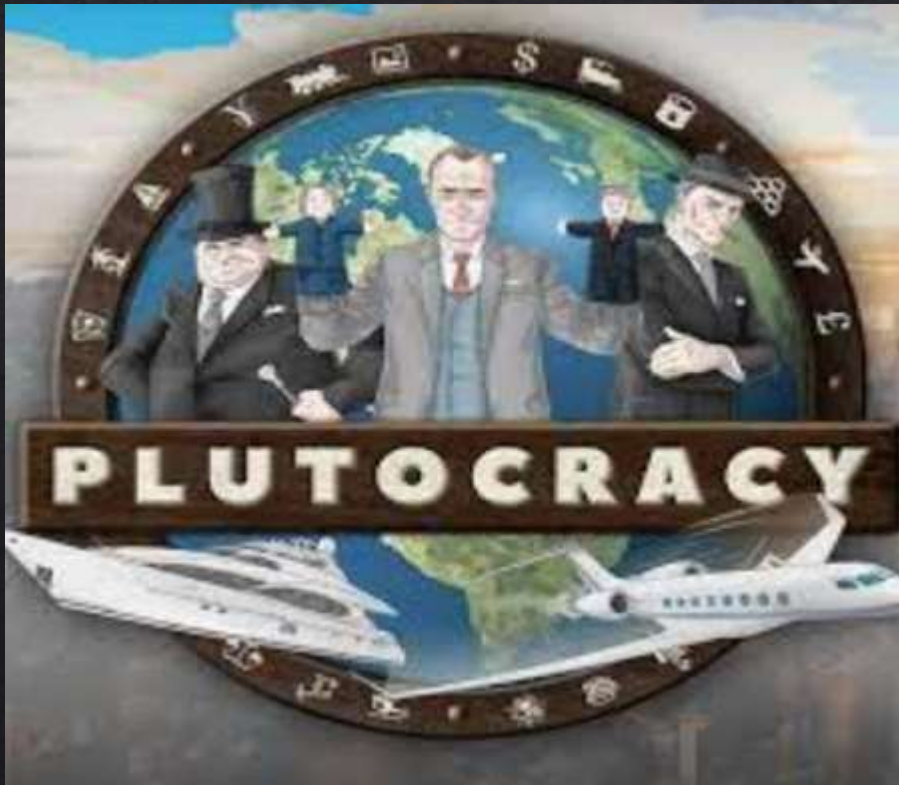


**Eg:-** It was difficult for the couple to go to the orphanage to adopt an orphan because all of the boys and girls wanted parents.



**28.Plutocracy** :- Government governed by wealth. धनिक तंत्र

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**Eg:-** This auspicious plutocracy helped to establish the first roadways in the area inaugurated in 1882.

**29.Plagiarism:-** Copying someone else's work and trying to submit it as your own साहित्यिक चोरी

**Mnemonic :-** play करते ही पता चल रहा है ये tune plagiarism करके ली है

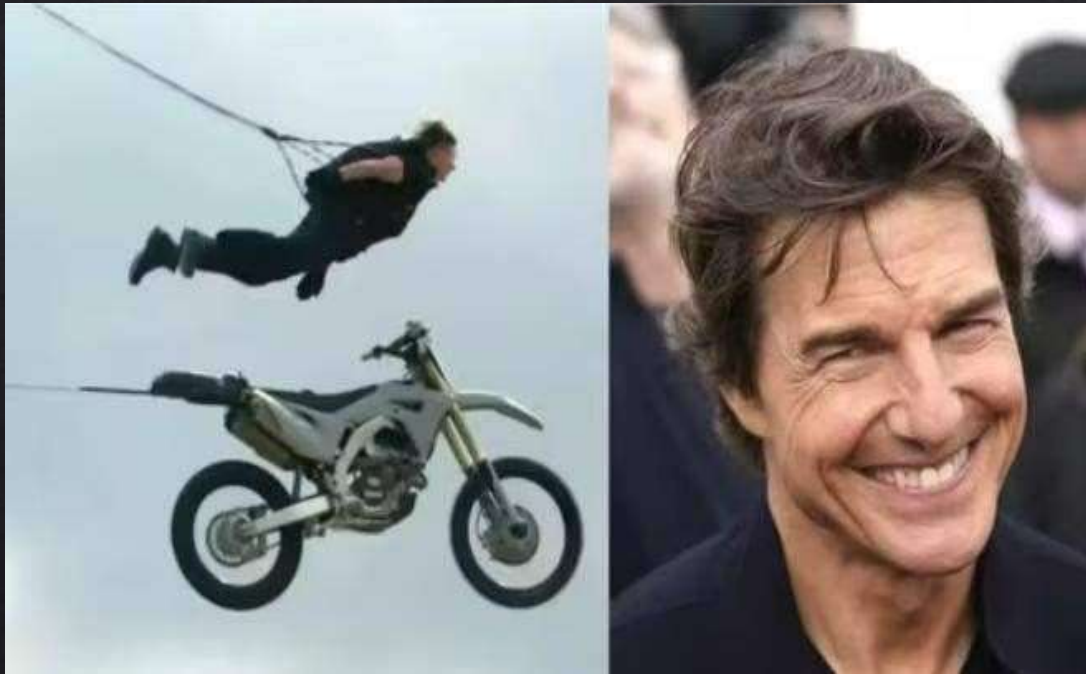


**Ex:-** Students are deemed guilty of plagiarism when they claim to be the author of somebody else's work.



**30.Daredevil:-** A person who enjoys doing dangerous things, in a way that other people may think is stupid. साहसी

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**Eg:-** The actor performed his own daredevil stunts in the action movie.

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**31.Waif** :- Forsaken or neglected child who has no home and spends most of his/her time on the streets. असहाय

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Eg:- After noticing the female waif begging for food on the streets, it became apparent to the tourists that it had been a long time since she had a proper meal.

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**32.Convalescence:-** Gradual recovery of health and strength.

स्वास्थ्यलाभ

**Mnemonic :-** colonel well हो रहा है sense वापस आ रही है  
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**Eg:-** The first step towards his convalescence is a reduction in the amount of stimulant or alcohol.

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**33.Aviary** :- A place where birds are kept. जहाँ पक्षियों को रखा जाता है

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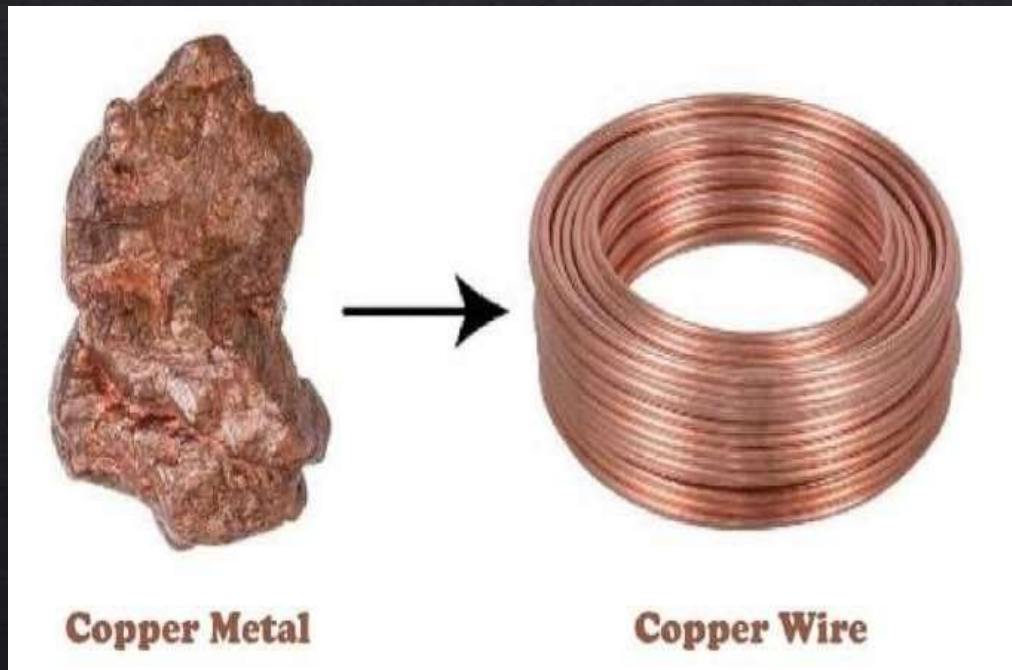
**Eg:-** Keeping different types of birds in one aviary requires knowledge of both habitats and needs.

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**34.Ductile:-** capable of being bent or pulled into different shapes. तन्य

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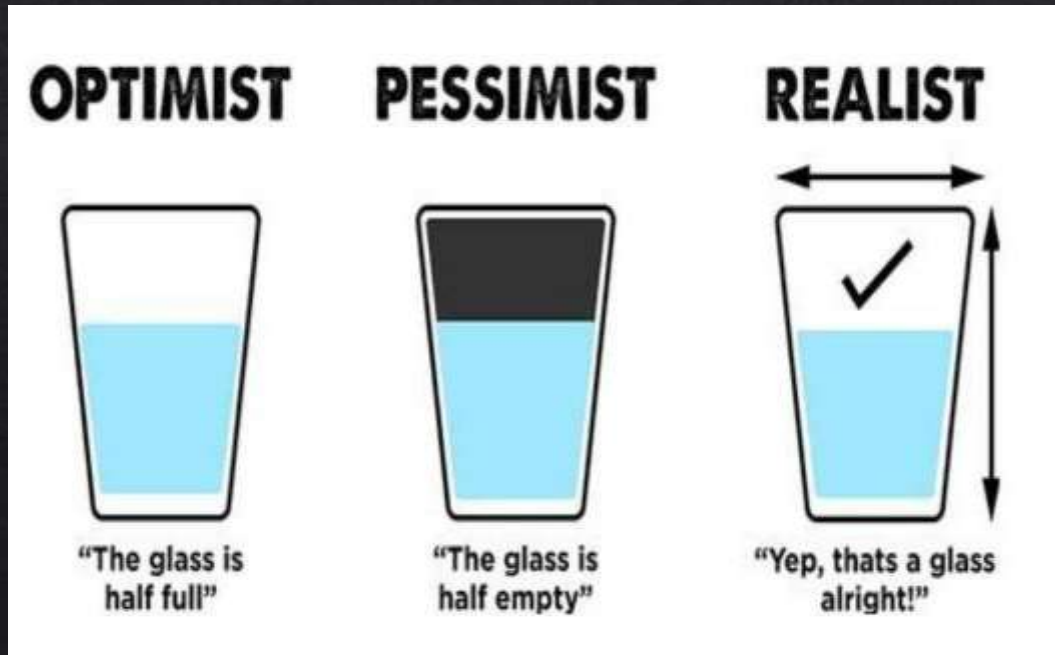


**Eg:-** Copper is often used to make wire because it is ductile and bends easily but doesn't break.

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**35.Pessimist:-** One who looks at the negative side of everything. निराशावादी

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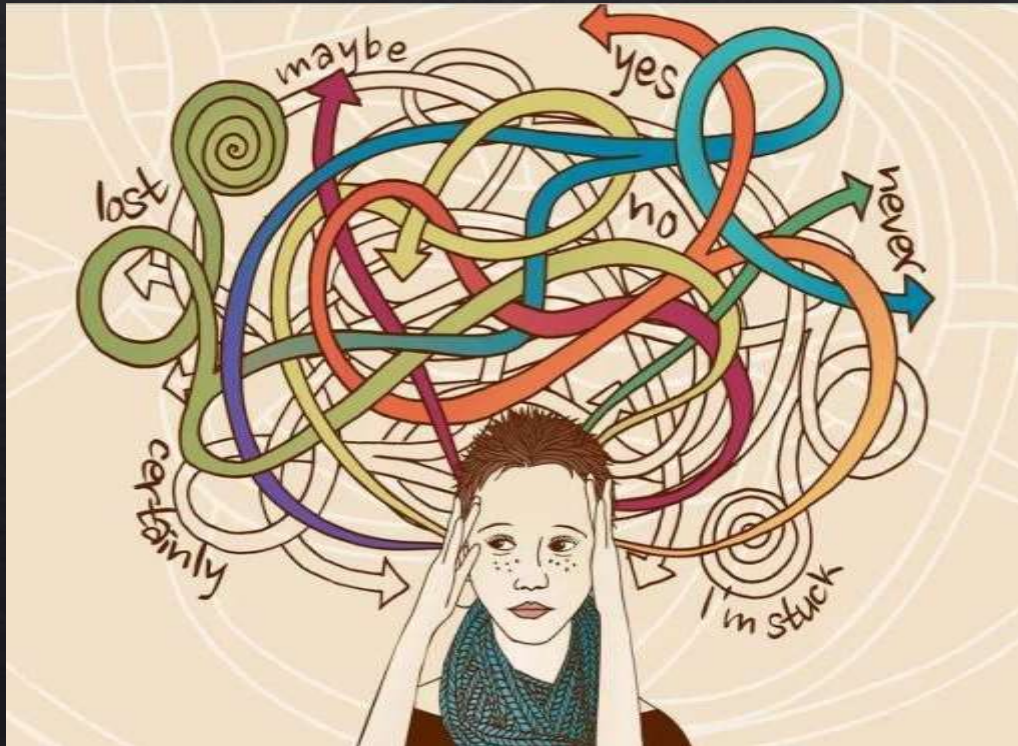
**Eg:-** Because Heena has a pessimistic attitude, she never believes anything good will happen to her.

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**36. Vacillate:-** Waver between different opinions or actions निश्चय ना कर पाना/विचार बदलते रहना

**Mnemonic :-** तेरे car या bus में vacillate की वजह से वैसे ही late हो गए

**Eg:-** It is common for people to vacillate when it comes to choosing lottery numbers.

**37.Imposter:-** One who pretends to be somebody else. पाखंडी;  
ढोंगी

**Mnemonic :-** I am on this this poster

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**Eg:-** Gajju is an imposter who deceives others by claiming to be one of their relatives.

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**38.Assassin:-**A person who kills somebody, especially for political reasons. हत्यारा }

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**Eg:-** She hired an assassin to eliminate her rival.

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**39.Congregation:-** A group of worshippers. धर्मसंघ

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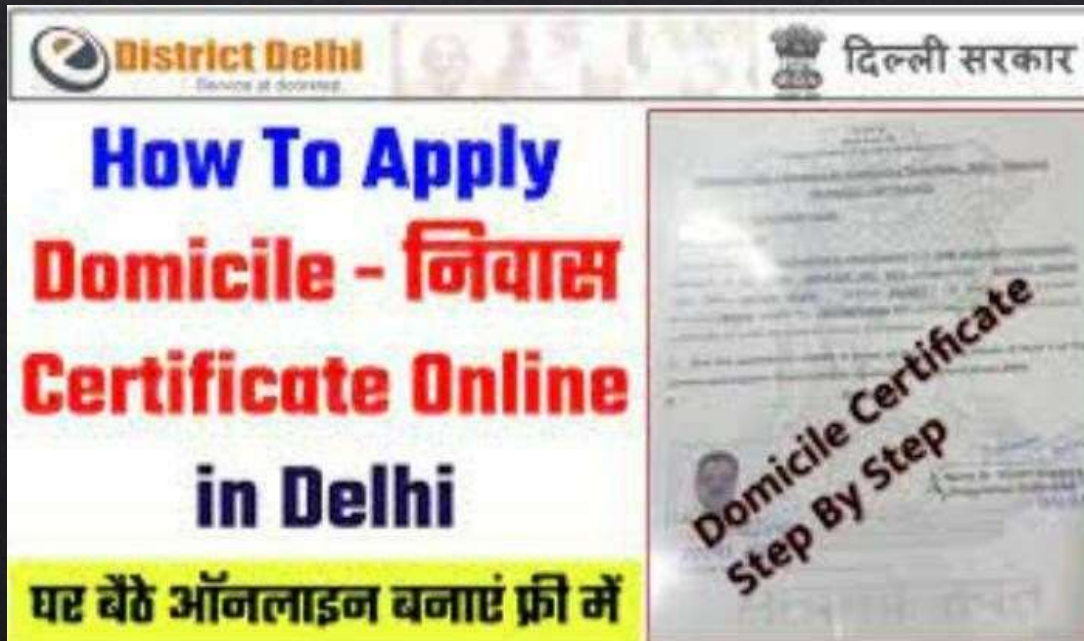
**Eg:-** The congregation had no place to worship after their church was burned to the ground.

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**40.Domicile:-** The place that a person treats as his permanent home, or lives in and has a substantial connection with. आवास

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**Eg:-** The postal office couldn't locate his domicile, so they were holding his mail.

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**41.Granary:-** A storehouse for threshed grain. धान्यागार

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**Eg:-** The truck driver was sent to the local granary to pick up several pounds of wheat from the storeroom.

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**42.Slouch:-** to stand, sit, or walk with the shoulders hanging forward and the head bent slightly over so that you look tired and bored: आगे झुक कर बैठना

**Mnemonic :-** don't slouch on the couch

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**Eg:-** Be aware of your body language, do not slouch in the chair.

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**43.Deaf:-** One who cannot hear. बहरा

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**Eg:-** She is deaf, but refuses to let her disability prevent her from doing what she wants to do.

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**44.Malevolent:-** Causing or wanting to cause harm or evil to someone. बहुत बुरा/नुकसान पहुँचाने वाला

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**Eg:-** I can't believe she dated him for so long without discovering his cruel, malevolent nature.

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**45.Fatal:-** Causing or ending in death. घातक/जानलेवा

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**Eg:-** The police are investigating a fatal car crash that occurred last night.

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**46.Fatalist:-** One who believes in fate. भाग्यवादी



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**Eg:-** The fatalist was not upset when she was fired because she believed all situations are predetermined by God.

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**47.Pact:-** A formal agreement between two or more nations or persons. समझौता

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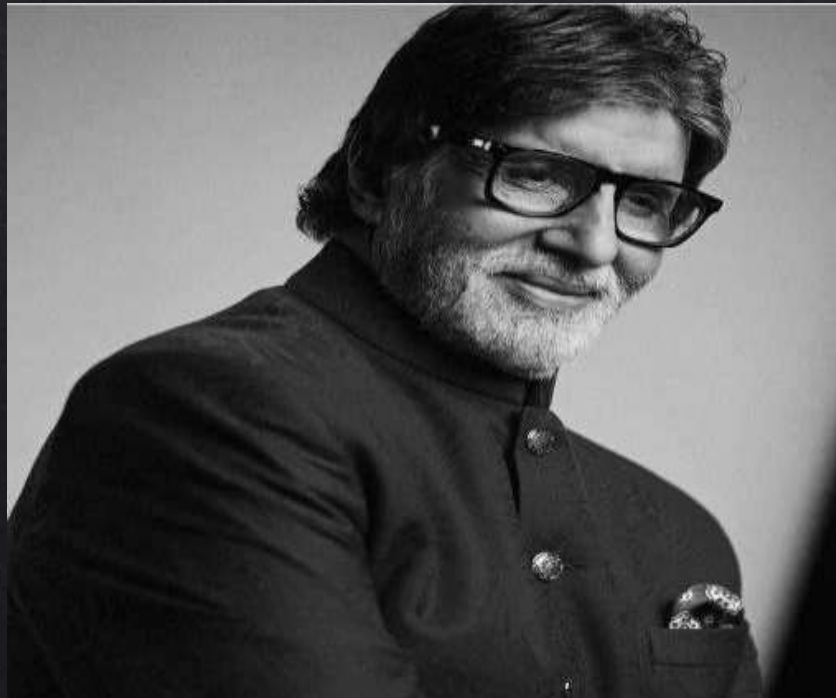
**Eg:-** He made a pact with her daughter that she would call every night while away on her business trip

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**48.Septuagenarian:-** A person whose age is between 70 and 79 years. सत्तर वर्ष की अवस्था का मनुष्य

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**Eg:-** It is a great relief when you are a septuagenarian and have retired.

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**49.Adventurous:-** Willing to take risks and try new ideas. साहसी

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**Eg:-** Exploring dark caves in his spare time, the adventurous risk-taker enjoyed a good quest.

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**50.Shuttle:-** A shuttle is a plane, bus, or train which makes frequent journeys between two places. नियमित आवागमन यात्रा सेवा

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**Eg:-** A shuttle runs between the city center and the theme park.

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**51.Philanthropist:-** One who loves mankind. परोपकारी

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**Eg:-** The money was left by a philanthropist to build a hospital ward.

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**52.Bark:-** Outer protective layer of a tree. छाल

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Eg:- The sparrow sat on the bark of the tree.

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**53.Lexicography:-** The practice of writing dictionaries. शब्दकोश संकलन

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**Eg:-** The early nineteenth century saw a dramatic rise in the lexicography of music analysis.

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**54.Decoding:-** Changing secret and coded messages in a readable form. कूट शब्दों को अनुवाद करना

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**Eg:-** Decoding the paintings is not difficult once you know what the component parts symbolize.

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**55.Snug:-** (of a person) feeling warm, comfortable, and protected, or (of a place, especially a small place) giving feelings of warmth, comfort, and protection: आरामदायक

**Mnemonic :-** comfortable like a hug

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**Eg:-** We curled up in bed, all snug and warm, and listened to the storm outside.

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**56.Magnanimous:-** kind, generous and forgiving (especially towards an enemy or a competitor that you have beaten) उदार

**Root word** - magnus(big)- animus(soul)

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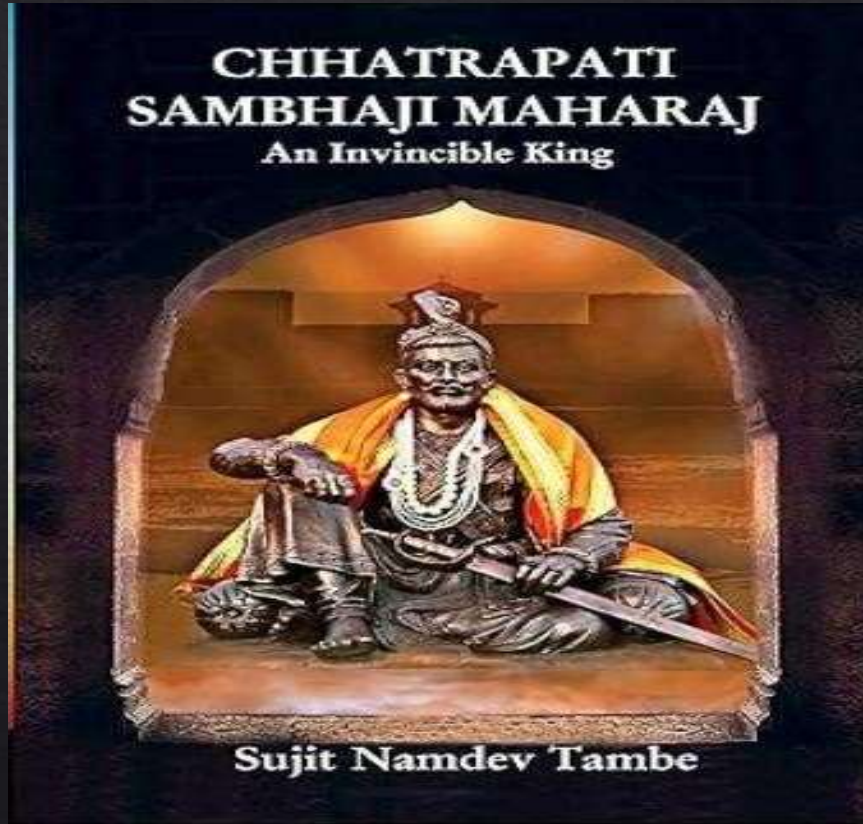


**Eg:-** Despite the slurs made against him by his opponent, the boxer was magnanimous enough to praise his competitor.

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**57.Invincible:-**that can not be defeated or changed. अजेय

**Mnemonic :-** in (not) + win + able



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**Eg:-** The team proved it was not invincible when it lost the last game of the season.

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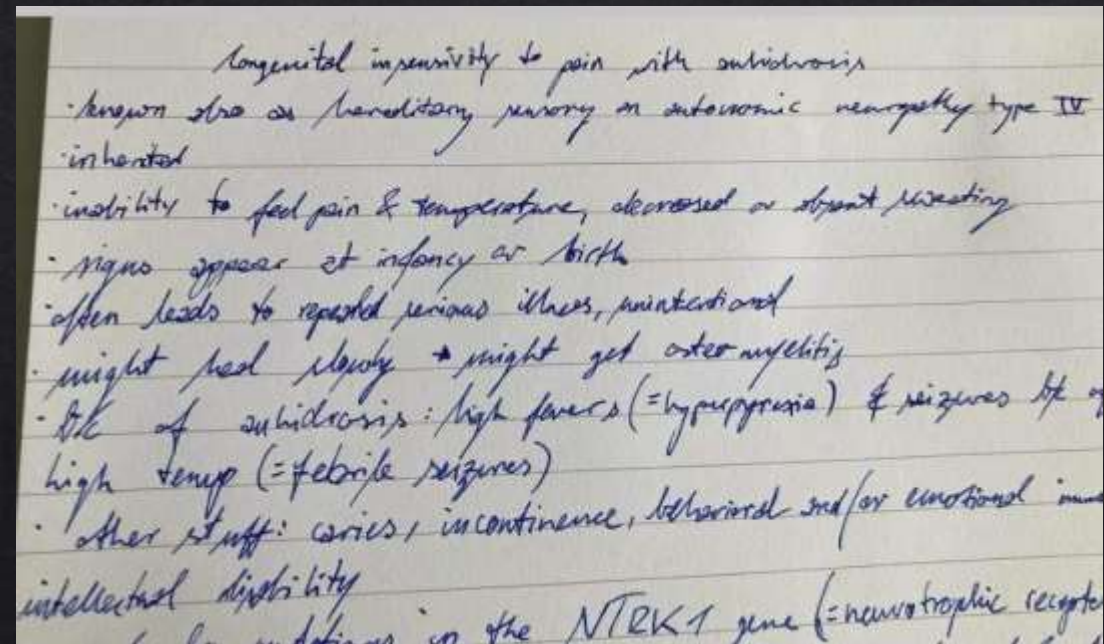
**58.Illegible:-** Which cannot be read. जिसे पढ़ा नहीं जा सकता

**Mnemonic :-** तुम्हारी handwriting illegible है इसलिए you are not eligible for this post.

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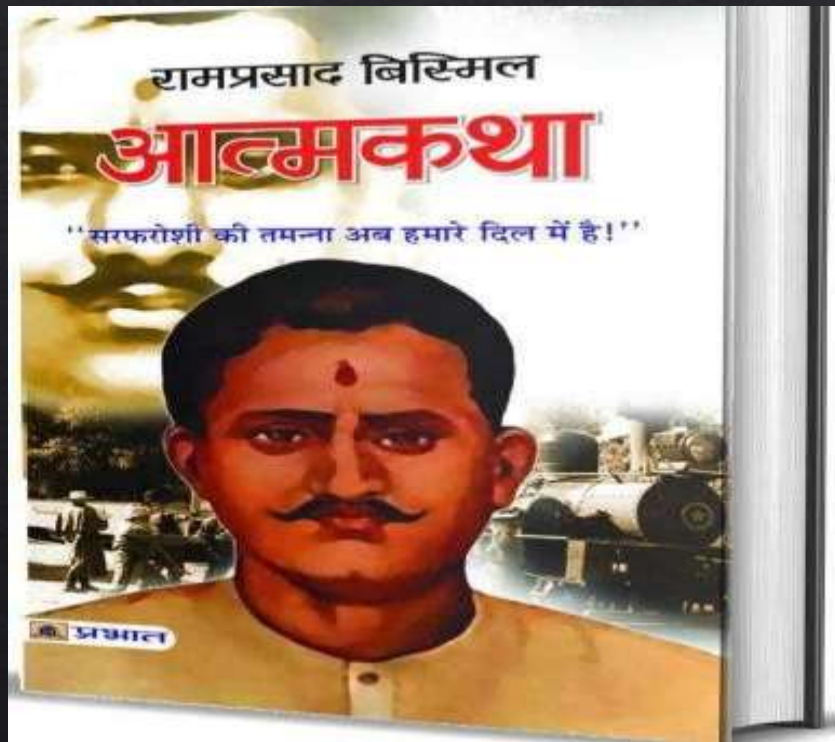
**Eg:-** The cashier refused to cash my check because she could not understand the check writer's illegible signature

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**59. Autobiography:-** Life history written by oneself . आत्मकथा

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**Eg:-** He gives a vivid description of his childhood in his autobiography.

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**60.Genocide:-** The murder of a large number of people from a particular nation or ethnic group. जन-संहार

**Root word :-** genos(race) + cide(killing)

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**Eg:-** Armed troops are being sent to end the dictator's genocide that has resulted in the deaths of over twenty thousand people.

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**61.Wreath:-** an arrangement of flowers and leaves in a circular shape, used as a decoration or as a sign of respect and remembrance for a person who has died. पुष्पमाला

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**Eg:-** Many front doors feature a wreath to welcome visitors.

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**62. Teetotaller:-** one who does not drink alcohol जो शराब ना पीता हो

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**Eg:-** Babulal is recently become a strict teetotaller.

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**63.Hangar:-** a place where aircraft are kept when not in use.  
विमानशाला

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**Eg:-** Because the hangar was damaged during the storm, we had to place the airplane in a local barn.

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**64.Cemetery:-** a graveyard where dead bodies are buried. कब्रिस्तान

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**Eg:-** When planning for her funeral, the dying woman chose the perfect cemetery plot to be buried beneath.

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**65.Cosmopolitan:-** Someone who regards the world as his country. सर्वव्यापी



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**Eg:-** I love big cities and the rootless cosmopolitan culture that comes with them.

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**66.Oblivious:-** Not informed about or aware of something  
बेखबर

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**Eg:-** His eyes were closed and he was completely oblivious to what was happening around him.

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**67.Hysterical:-** unable to control your feelings or behaviour because you are extremely frightened, angry, excited, etc. आपा खोना

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**Eg:-** She became hysterical when she heard the news.

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
