Word – Greg, Meaning - Flock/herd group.

Aggregate -To combine by grouping.

Eg:- Schools often use test scores to aggregate students into classes based on intelligence.

Segregate- to separate in groups.

Eg:-Society was legally segregated by race in much of the country.

Gregarious - living with the herd.

Eg:- Lalita was an open, gregarious, kind individual, who loved people.

Word – Greg, Meaning - Flock/herd group.

Aggregation - A collection, a union into a mass.

Eg:- Females are more often found separate from the aggregation than males.

Congregate - to flock together group.

Eg:-This year, we're congregating back in my home.

Congregation - A group of religious people.

Eg:- The members of the congregation bowed their heads in prayer.

Word – Greg, Meaning - Flock/herd group.

Segregation - separation into groups.

Eg:- Feminists complain about segregation between men and women in the workplace.

Segregationist - one who believes in segregation.

Eg:- This was a period in which the segregationist played a leading role in the Democratic Party.

Anti-segregationist- one who is against segregation.

Eg:-Mahatma Gandhi was an Anti-segregationist.

Word – Fide Meaning - Faith (fayary)

Mala fide - mal (bad) + fide (faith) -in bad faith.

Eg:- They are trying to prove that the company and its foreign associates acted with mala fide intent.

Fidelity – faithfulness.

Eg:-I value him for his fidelity to myself.

Infidel - one who does not have the right faith.

Eg:- He has been named as infidel on Syrian TV several times.

Word – Fide Meaning - Faith (fayary)

Bona fide - In good faith/genuine.

Eg:- Make sure you are dealing with a bona fide company..

Infidelity - unfaithfulness towards the partner.

Eg:- Infedelity between them resulted in divorce.

Word-Somn/somni/somna, Meaning-Sleep.

Somnambulist - one who walks while sleeping.

Eg:- Rajat is a somnambulist and one night he killed a bull with his gun.

Somnambulism - A disease of walking while sleeping.

Eg:- She spent much of her time in a state of somnambulism.

Somniloquist - one who talks while sleeping.

Eg:- He often mumbles in night so he must be a Somniloquist.

Word-Somn/somni/somna, Meaning-Sleep.

Somniloquism - disease of talking while sleeping.

Eg:- Somniloquism is common among children.

Insomnia - disease of having no sleep.

Eg:- Irritability and insomnia are natural side effects of midnight activities.

Somnolent -feeling sleepy.

Eg:-David gave the somnolent crowd a reason to cheer.

Word-Somn/somni/somna, Meaning-Sleep.

Somnific - causing sleep.

Eg:- I was powerfully affected by the changeless somnific quality of Zara's tones.

Euphony (sound) - eu (good) + phonys (sound) - good sound. Eg: The poet has chosen her words more for euphony than factual accuracy.

Euphemism - to say bad things in good & sweet words. Eg:- The article made so much use of euphemism that often its meaning was unclear.

Eulogy - good speech — speech to praise someone Eg:- The song was a eulogy to the joys of travelling.

Euphoria (feeling) - good feeling/ pleasant feeling.

Eg:- They were in a state of euphoria for days after they won the prize.

Euphoric - having the feel of euphoria.

Eg:-Indians were euphoric at the extraordinary victory in cricket match.

Euthanasia - good death — wishful death

Eg:-They're promoting euthanasia as a humane alternative to slaughter.

Euphonious - Full of pleasing sound.

Eg:- It seems to me to be both descriptive and euphonious.

Eulogise - To say praising words for someone.

Eg:-At his funeral, he was eulogised by everyone.

Eureka - An expression of triumph.

Eg:- "Eureka!" she shouted as the engine started.

Eupepsia (digestion) - good digestion.

Eg:-It will provide you with eupepsia and keep your tummy happy.

Word – Nov, Meaning – New.

Novel -new

Eg:- Novel Ideas.

Novelty – newness.

Eg:-My companion had never eaten sushi before and found the whole experience a novelty.

Novice - new corner, inexperienced.

Eg:- This plant can be difficult for novice gardeners to grow.

Word – Nov, Meaning – New.

Innovate - to create something new.

Eg:-They are more successful today because they have continued to innovate.

Innovator - one who creates new things.

Eg:- She has won a reputation as a leading innovator in the industry.

Innovation - creation of new things.

Eg:- Dancing on toe was an innovation that quickly became the norm.

Word – Nov, Meaning – New.

Renovate - to make something new again.

Eg:-We should renovate our house now.

Renovation - making something new again.

Eg:-It will become a much more attractive facility after the renovation.

De novo - to start afresh.

Eg:-I have adventured to publish it de novo in this book.

Word-Syn/sym, Meaning - Same

Synonym - syn (same) same meaning /Name.

Eg:- Multiple synonyms can be used for a term.

Synchronisation syn (same) + chron (time) - at the same time.

Eg:- It was virtually impossible to synchronise our lives so as to take holidays together.

Synergy - syn + energy - same energy.

Eg:- Synergy between to friends/ companies

Word-Syn/sym, Meaning - Same

Symphony - sym (same) + phony (sound) - having same sound. Eg:- The air is filled will a symphony of croaks.

Synagogue - Meeting at the same place by jews.

Eg:- Early talks are also under way to open up synagogues.

Syndicate - A body of business people working together for same purpose.

Eg:- We could syndicate and make a lot of money.

Word-Syn/sym, Meaning - Same

- Symmetry having the same shape on both sides.
- Eg:- The symmetry of the spider web was so unique I took a picture of it.
- Symposium A gathering of same kind of people for discussing the same purpose.
- Eg:- Experts gathered for an international symposium on Internet addiction.
- Sympathy The act of feeling same emotion as another.
- Eg:- The president has sent a message of sympathy to the relatives of the dead soldiers.

Logomania - Excessive talkativeness.

Eg:-I just talked and talked unstoppably as if possessed by logomania.

Logomaniac - one who is "Crazy" about words.

Logomisia - Disgust for certain words.

Logonomy - (Science) Science of words.

Logophile - lover of words.

Eg:- He is a writer and a logophile.

Logophobia - Fear of certain words.

Eg:- Children with learning disorders or logophobia may still cultivate a love for books with graphic novels, comics, or picture books.

Misologia - hatred of speaking.

Neologism -

- 1. A newly coined word.
- 2. Coining of new words

Eg:- This neologism has not gained widespread acceptance in the mathematical community.

Neologist -A person who coins new words.

Eg:-John Algeo, the neologist of American Speech, points to the two-way working of the metaphor.

Pseudologia - Unreasonably lying in speech or writing.

Word-Logue, Meaning - A particular written or spoken form.

Catalogue - A list or names articles.

Eg:-I knew every catalogue number.

Dialogue - A conversation between two or more persons.

Eg:-The dialogue is sharp and funny.

Prologue - Introduction to a discourse/poem play/ drama.

Eg:-I wasn't feeling confident until after the prologue.

Word-Logue, Meaning - A particular written or spoken form.

Monologue (single)- A speech by a person alone.

Eg:-He interrupted a young man in the middle of his monologue.

Travelogue - A description of some one's travel.

Eg:-A quick Google search turns up someone's travelogue.

Polylogue - A Speech by several person.

Eg:- Answers to thematic questions should be worked out during a polylogue.

Word-Logue, Meaning - A particular written or spoken form.

Monopolylogue - Mono+poly+logue - A speech by a single of many characters in a particular play.

Epidermis - outer layer of the skin.

Eg:- Certainly, it vaporizes the aged epidermis into water and steam.

Dermatology - study of skin.

Dermatologist - skin specialist.

Pachyderm – animal having thick skin.

Eg:- The elephant is in many ways a pachyderm.

Hypodermic - below the skin.

Eg:- Suddenly he is stabbed by a hypodermic needle and goes unconscious.

Dermal- Related to skin.

Eg:- Prolonged contact on the skin can cause a little dermal irritation,

Dermabrasion - removal of upper layer of the skin.

Scleroderma - hardening of the skin.

Transdermal - medicine through skin.

Taxidermy - the activity of preserving skin of animals.

Taxidermist - one who does taxidermy.

Dermitis - skin disease.

Word-Xeno, Meaning - 1.foreign, 2. Outside the domestic or local area

Xenocide -killing of all alien/foreign species

Xenophyte - any plant growing outside the particular geographic loacation.

Xenomania - mania of foreigners.

Xenophobia - fear of foreigners.

Word-Xeno, Meaning - 1.foreign, 2. Outside the domestic or local area

Xenolinguistic - related to foreign language.

Xenium - A place for outsiders to sit in.

Xenogamy - Marriage outside Caste / level.

Xenogamous - One who is married to outside his caste level.

Misoxenist - A hater of strangers.

Misoxeny - hate towards strangers.

Word - Taph/tapho/taphia, Meaning- tomb.

Epitaph - words written on tomb.

Epitapher - A writer of epitaph.

Taphophobia - Phobia of tombs.

Cenotaph - an empty tomb in memory of someone.

Eg:-A programme was held in Delhi on the cenotaph of the warriors of Kargil war.

Word - Taph/tapho/taphia, Meaning- tomb.

Taphophile - Lover of tombs.

Taphophilia - Love for tombs.

Taphophobe - One who has taphophobia.

Word- Phago/Pgag/phage/Phag, Meaning- eating/to consume

Andropagous - The eating of a man.

Anthophagous -The eating of flowers.

Aphagia - A+ phagia - not eating - Aphagia is the inability or refusal to swallow.

Word- Phago/Pgag/phage/Phag, Meaning- eating/to consume

Aphagopraxia - the loss of ability to eat.

Eg:- My grand mother is suffering from apgagopraxia.

Phagomania - mania of eating.

Aphagosis - A+phagosis - Inability to eat.

Arachnophagous - eating spiders.

Word- Phago/Pgag/phage/Phag, Meaning- eating/to consume

Airophagy -exessive swallowing of air.

Carpophagous - (Fruit) fruit eating.

Phagophobia - phobia of eating.

Word – Avi, Meaning - Bird/fly (Bird flies).

Aviate - to fly in the air.

Eg:- Eagle aviates like a lion of the sky.

Aviator - who flies planes, pilot.

Eg:- Aviator assured everybody for a safe landing.

Aviatrix - female pilot.

Eg:-Now a days aviatrixes are more talented than aviators.

Word – Avi, Meaning - Bird/fly (Bird flies).

Avionics - electronics in aircraft.

Eg:- Indian Air Force will check the avionics of Rafael and then will give a tendor to France.

Aviary - A place where birds are kept.

Eg:- You can buy any kind of bird from the aviary next to my villa.

Avian - related to birds.

Eg:- Ellen loves to read the avian books because he is a bird lover.

Word – Luc, Meaning - Bright, light.

Lucent - glowing with or giving of light.

Eg:- Because it was overcast, I could not see the lucent moon in the sky.

Elucidate - to throw light upon a topic/ to explain.

Eg:- The full picture has not been elucidated yet.

Lucid - clear, bright.

Eg:- In her more lucid moments the old lady would talk about her past.

Word – Luc, Meaning - Bright, light.

Lucifer - bearer of light.

Translucent - allowing light to pass through.

Eg:- Laura's skin has a translucent quality.
