

1. Vigorous:- Active and strong in a physical sense {ज़ोरदार}

Mnemonics:- wo gaur se dekh rhi thi isliye ladka vigorous exercise karne lga

Synonyms:- Effective, Robust, Potent

Antonyms:- Apathetic, Lethargic, Sluggish

Eg:- In order to look great at her wedding, Crystal has started a vigorous workout program.

2.Calamity:- A situation that results in extreme suffering {आपदा}

Mnemonics:- calamity aane se har jagah kalah mach gyi

Synonyms:- Adversity, Disaster, Collapse

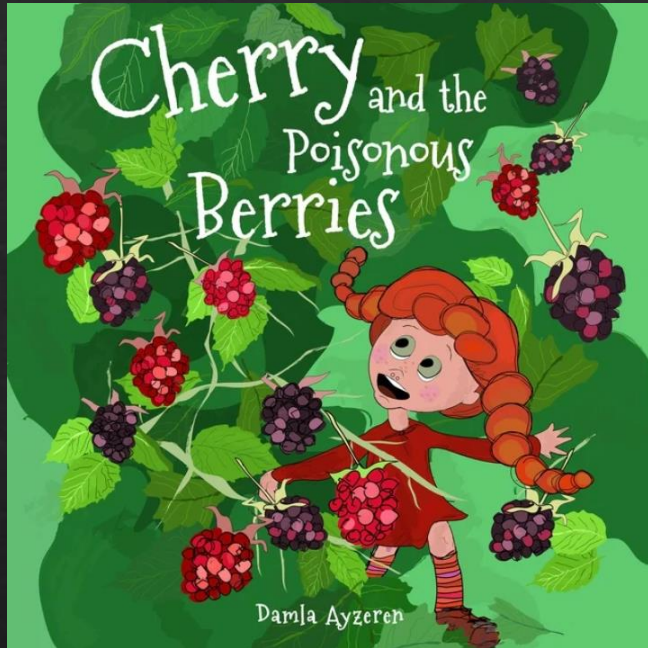
Antonyms:- Advantage, Miracle, Boon

Eg:- The approaching hurricane is sure to be a calamity that will affect the lives of millions.

3.Chary:- Apprehensive about doing something {सावधान}

Mnemonics:- you should be chary about poisonous berry

Antonyms:- Heedless, Carefree, Rash

Eg:- School authorities are incredibly chary about hiring people with criminal backgrounds.

4.Encounter:- To come across something or someone without warning {सामने होना}

Synonyms:- Meeting, Clash, Bump-into

Antonyms:- Ignore, Dodge, Retreat

Eg:- I never dreamed I would encounter my ex girlfriend at a hospital.

5.Fury:- Intense anger {क्रोध}

Mnemonics:- boss fury me hume fire kar dega

Synonyms:- Rage, Acrimony, Ferocity

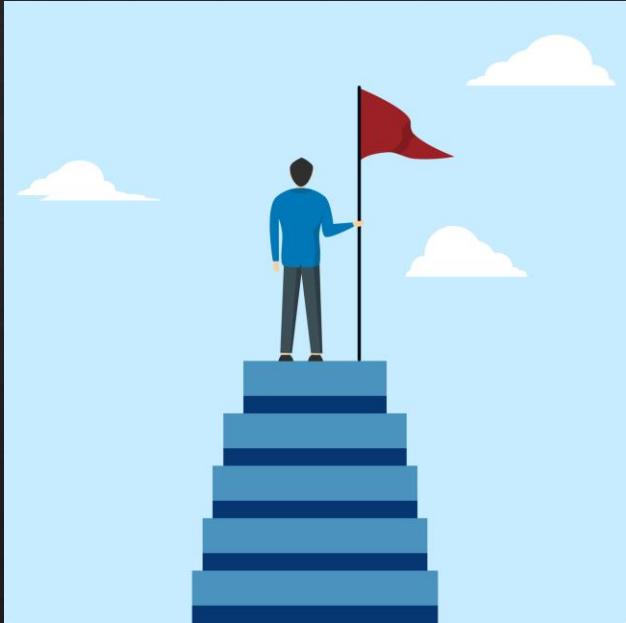
Antonyms:- Calmness, Mildness, Glee

6.Pinnacle:- The uppermost level achievable {शिखर}

Mnemonics:- pisoge akele tab Jake milega pinnacle

Antonyms:- Bottom, Nadir, Base

Eg:- At the pinnacle of her career, Gail was on the cover of every entertainment magazine.

7. **Vociferous**:- Making a loud outcry {ज़ोर की आवाज़ का}

Mnemonics:- Voice + force / voice fir se ucchi kar di

Synonyms:- Blatant, Clamant, Clamorous

Antonyms:- Silent, Soft-spoken, Polite

Eg:- The protestors were vociferous as they screamed outside of the government building.

8. Vituperate:- To insult or verbally attack someone using abusive language {निंदा करना}

Mnemonics:- katu + parvachan



Synonyms:- Criticize, Abuse, Berate

Antonyms:- Appraise, Acclaim, Applause

Eg:- The woman's husband tends to vituperate her when he drinks, always insulting her with foul remarks.

9.Hoodwink:- To trick or deceive someone {धोखा देना}

Mnemonics:- hood ke muh chupa ke wink to trick someone Aman Sir English



Synonyms:- Deceive, Defraud, Mislead

Antonyms:- Protect, Help, Assist

Eg:- After the hurricane, many dishonest individuals tried to hoodwink generous people into donating to fake charities.

10.Permeate:- To pass or spread through {आरपार निकलना}

Mnemonics:- parmatma ki takat har jagah permeate kar sakti hai

Synonyms:- Invade, Peirce, Transfuse

Antonyms:- Concentrate, Retract, Blocked

Eg:- The light will permeate through the curtain when the sun rises.

11.Irrevocable:- Unable to be changed or reversed {अनुरूप होना}

Mnemonics:- ir +rok (stop) + able

Synonyms:- Immutable, Constant, Unalterable

Antonyms:- Alterable, Reversible, Revocable

Eg:- Even though you are unhappy with your inheritance, the will is irrevocable and cannot be changed.

12. Ignoble:- Not deserving respect {नीच}

Mnemonics:- not noble

Synonyms:- Lowly, Unworthy, Contemptible

Antonyms:- Dignified, Noble, Reputable

Eg:- Because Frank has a habit of not showing up on time, he has an ignoble reputation as someone who is not very responsible.

13.Plea:- A humble request for help from someone in authority {निवेदन}

Mnemonics:- please (request)

Antonyms:- Demand, Decision, Sentence

Eg:- We are making a plea to all companies to stop polluting the environment.

14.Muddy:- Covered with mud {मैला}

Mnemonics:- covered with mud

Synonyms:- Filthy, Dirty, Blurred

Antonyms:- Bright, Clean, Hygenic

Eg:- She looked muddy and furious .

15.Futile:- incapable of producing any results {व्यर्थ}

Mnemonics:- futi hui tiles futile hai

Synonyms:- Failure, Fruitless, Unproductive

Antonyms:- Fruitful, Helpful, Productive

Eg:- The losing team made a valiant but futile effort to catch up to their opponent.

16.Morose:- In a bad mood {उदास}

Mnemonics:- mar jaye jab koi close hum hote hai morose

Synonyms:- Gloomy, Glum, Depressed

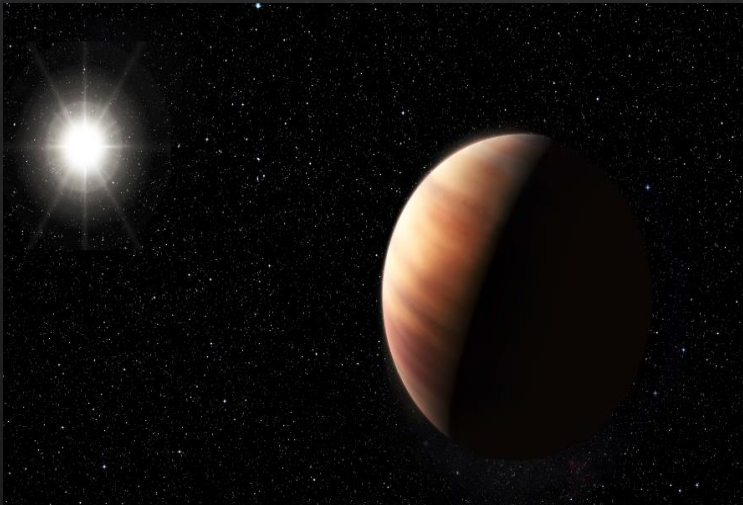
Antonyms:- Cheerful, Gentle, Joyful

17.Distant:- far away from each other {दूर का}

Mnemonics:- a lot of distance

Antonyms:- Approachable, Nearby, Adjacent

Eg:- The most distant celestial body from the Sun in our solar system is Pluto.

18.Eccentric:- a person with an unusual or odd personality {विचित्र}

Mnemonics:- jis dimag center me na ho

Synonyms:- Bizarre, Erratic, Idiosyncratic

Antonyms:- Conventional, Familiar, Standard

Eg:- My eccentric aunt has been known to laugh at funerals.

19.Advertise:- To publicly promoted a product or service
{प्रसिद्ध करना}

Mnemonics:- tv advertisement

Synonyms:- Promote, Endorse, Exhibit

Antonyms:- Hide, Suppress, withhold

Eg:- The celebrity agreed to endorse the product the company wanted to advertise as long as she got paid for taking part in the promotion.

20. Vivid:- strikingly bright or intense {उज्ज्वल}

Mnemonics:- video vivid thi / vividh details

Synonyms:- Animated, Bright, Lucid

Antonyms:- Bland, Boring, Dark

Eg:- The artist was known for his vivid paintings that were distinguished by their colorful hues.

21.Moral:- A lesson {शिक्षा}

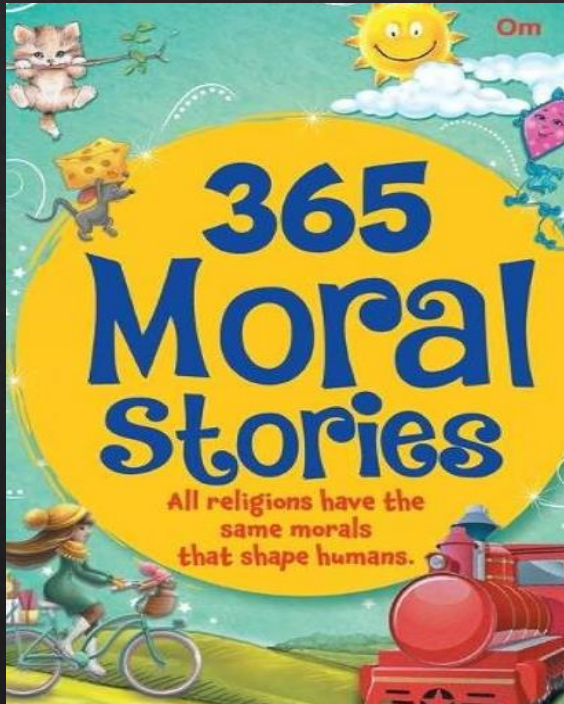
Mnemonics:- moral of the story

Synonyms:- Meaning, Significance, Adage

Antonyms:- Immoral, Unethical

Eg:- Parents tell their children the story of The Boy Who Cried Wolf because the moral teaches them not to lie.

22.Nexus:- The means of connection between things, A meeting point { कड़ी }

Synonyms:- Center, Core, Link

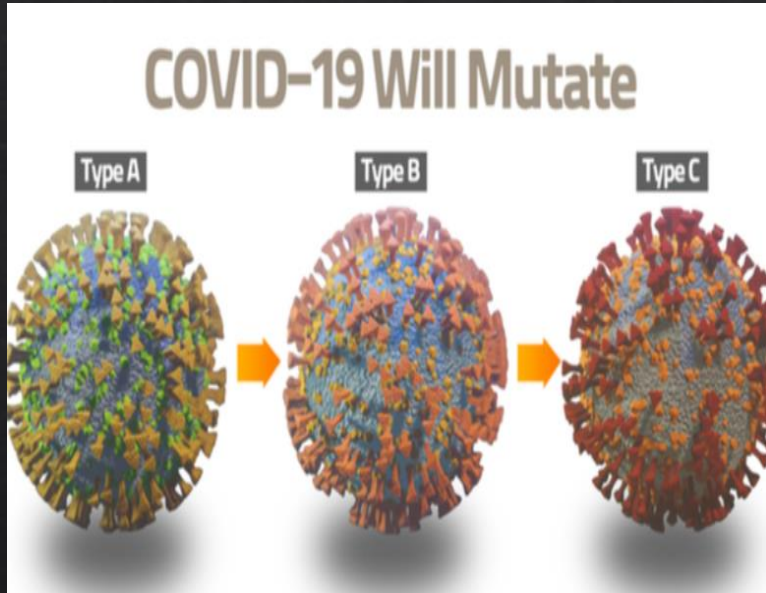
Antonyms:- Exterior, Outside

Eg:- The school cafeteria is the nexus of student activity.

23.Mutate:- To change {रूप बदलना}

Mnemonics:- mutation

Synonyms:- Alter, Mend, Modify

Antonyms:- Remain, Original, Stay

Eg:- Technology continues to mutate at an alarming rate.

24.Deliberate:- To think or talk seriously about something
{सोचा-समझा}

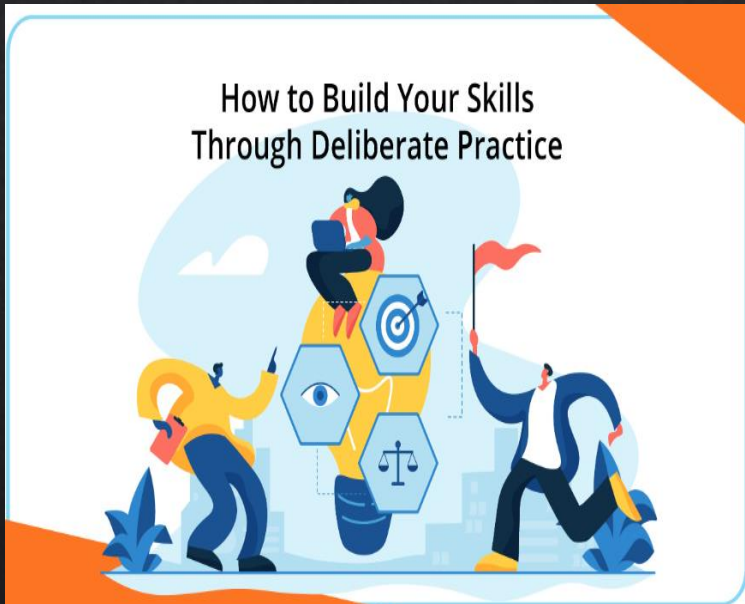

the road trip.



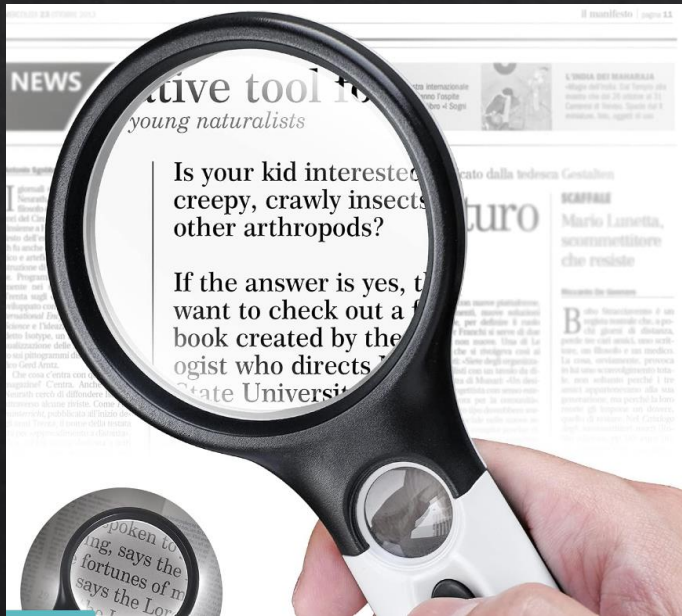

Mnemonics:- magnifying glass

Antonyms:- Compress, Diminish, Lessen

Eg:- My sister is an exaggerator who likes to magnify even the smallest symptoms when she is sick.

26. Stagnant:- not moving or increasing {स्थिर}

Mnemonics:- stay at one place

Synonyms:- Dormant, Idle, Inactive

Antonyms:- Active, Lively, Energetic

Eg.:- Because John needs more money and his current salary has been stagnant for three years, he is looking for a new job.

27.Peril:- A source of danger {जोखिम}

Mnemonics:- prai naari se pyar / perilous

Aman Sir English

Synonyms:- Risk, Hazard, Jeopardy

Antonyms:- Protection, Security, Safeness

Eg.:- To avoid peril, Helen should leave her house before the hurricane gets any closer to shore.



28.Deceitful:- Dishonest or untruthful in actions or words {बेईमान}

Mnemonics:- dohke baaj / full receipt nhi di deceitful ne

Aman Sir English

Synonyms:- Dishonest, Insincere, Fraudulent

Antonyms:- Honest, Ethical, Forthright

Eg.:- She divorced her husband because he was deceitful .



29.Raucous:- behaving in a noisy and disorderly way {उग्र}

Mnemonics:- rakshash type awaj ya harkate

Synonyms:- Discordant, Harsh, Loud

Antonyms:- Low, Mild, Soft

Eg.:- Did you hear that shots were fired at the raucous rap concert ?

30.Frisk:- to pass your hands over someone's body in search of drugs or other weapons {ढेर}

Mnemonics:- bomb ka risk avoid karke liye karte hain frisk

Synonyms:- Search, Check, Inspect

Antonyms:- Overlook, Ignore, Neglect

Eg.:- The security guard had to frisk the visitors before they were allowed to enter the mall.



31.Mortify:- to put someone in the position of being embarrassed
{शर्मिंदा करना}

Aman Sir English

Mnemonics:- sharm se maarna / moti kha fasegi iss gate me



Synonyms:- Annoy, Chagrin, Disgrace

Antonyms:- Aid, Delight, Soothe

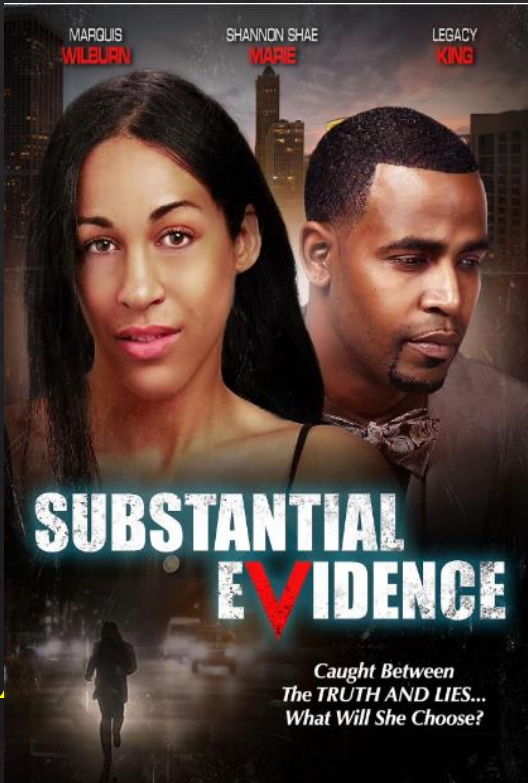
Eg.:- I am certain my sister meant to mortify me when she showed my date my baby pictures.

32.Substantial:- Referring to something that is greater or larger than normal {ज़ोरदार}

Mnemonics:- jis substance ho dum ho



Synonyms:- Massive, Significant, Sizable

Antonyms:- Broken, Minor, Worthless

Eg.:- After winning the lottery, the family won a substantial amount of money in which they didn't know how to spend it all.

33.Rebellion:- Refusal to accept some authority or code or convention {विद्रोह}

Mnemonics:- re gai bail ki charbi daal rhe bullet me
isliye rebellion hua



Synonyms:- Uprising, Insurgency, Defiance

Antonyms:- Obedience, Orthodoxy, Harmony

Eg:- Because many workers feel they are underpaid, they sometimes participate in acts of rebellion like organized “no shows”.

34.Hospitality:- Friendly and generous reception of guests {आदर}

Mnemonics:- hotel wale hospitality dikhate hain

Synonyms:- Accommodation, Companionship, Generosity

Antonyms:- Aloofness, Coolness, Hostility

Eg:- My grandmother is well known for her hospitality, as she often invites strangers into her home and feeds them well.



35.Fertile:- Capable of reproducing {उपजाऊ}

Aman Sir English



Synonyms:- Abundant, Arable, Fruitful

Antonyms:- Barren, Impotent, Sparse

Eg:- Because the ground is very fertile, we expect to grow a surplus of crops this year.

36.Casual:- Characterized by a feeling of irresponsibility
{अनौपचारिक, लापरवाह}

Synonyms:- Occasional, Offhand, Accidental

Antonyms:- Deliberate, Planned, Formal

Eg:- I find myself attracted to Amber's casual and relaxed personality because of how stress-free it makes me feel.

37.Cursed:- Plagued with misfortune, evil {शापित}

Mnemonics:- curse hua / kosa gya

Synonyms:- Bedeviled, Blasted, Unholy

Antonyms:- Blessed, Kind, Nice

Eg:- Cursed from birth, the royal family tried to figure out a way to save Sleeping Beauty from doom.

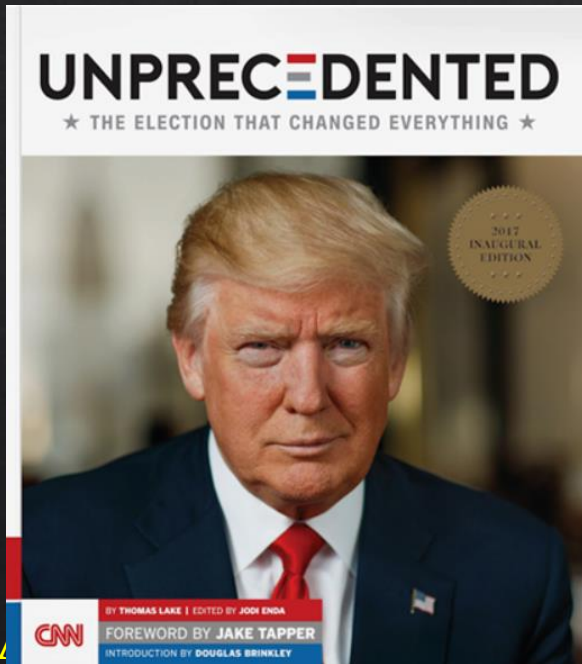

{अभूतपूर्व, अनोखा}

➤ **Synonyms:-** Bizzare, Miraculous, Unparalleled

➤ **Antonyms:-** Common, Usual, Familiar

Eg:- Before the storm, there was an unprecedented demand for food supplies that left many stores empty.

39.Diversity:- An assortment of different types {विचित्रता}

Mnemonics:- diverse

Synonyms:- Dissimilarity, Distinction, Multiplicity

Antonyms:- Similarity, Sameness, Uniformity

Eg:- India has a diversity of religions .

40.Polite:- Behavior that is respectful of other people {विनम्र}

Mnemonics:- pyar + light

Synonyms:- Mannerly, Amiable, Affable

Antonyms:- Impolite, Callous, Unkind

Eg:- If you want people to like you, you should probably be polite to them.



41.Ambition:- A desire to accomplish a task {कामना}

➤ **Synonyms:-** Aim, Goal, Aspiration

➤ **Antonyms:-** Laziness, Indifference, Disinterest



Eg:- Despite his old age, Frank has a very strong ambition to climb Mount Everest.

42.Deterrence:- Something that discourages one from doing something {अवरोध}
